<b>RHYTHMIC GYMNASTICS</b>	<p><i>Technical Rules</i></p> <p>Each country is authorised to enter a team in the following contests:</p> <p>a) Group exercise: 5 gymnasts (+ 1 authorised substitute)            Technical Programme: 5 ropes</p> <p>b) Individual contest: 1 to 4 gymnasts, 4 exercises per gymnast            Technical Programme: Hoop, Ball, Clubs, Ribbon</p> <p>The composition and the difficulty level of exercises must comply to the rules defined by the FIG 2017-2020 Code of Points for Rhythmic Gymnastics (Junior Programme).</p>	

	<p><i>Length of exercises:</i></p> <p>a) Individual: 1'15" – 1'30"</p> <p>b) Group: 2'15" – 2'30"</p> <p><i>Individual Competition</i></p> <p>Competition I:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• General classification of the gymnasts is decided by the total number of points on the 4 apparatus.</li> <li>• Classification of the 8 best gymnasts on each of the 4 apparatus for participation in Competition III.</li> </ul> <p>Competition III:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Apparatus finals: the best 8 gymnasts on each of the 4 apparatus – 2 gymnasts per country.</li> </ul> <p><i>Group Competition</i></p> <p>2 exercises – no finals. The group champion will perform a demonstration in the middle of the final individual competition (Competition III).</p>

### Composition of the Delegation

<b>BOXING</b>	<p>Maximum number of boxers: <b>26</b></p> <p>Maximum number of coaches: <b>6</b></p> <p>Divided as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Boys: max 1 boxer per weight category; 1 coach up to 4 boxers, 2 coaches up to 9 boxers, 3 coaches up to 13 boxers</li> <li>• Girls: max 1 boxer per weight category; 1 coach up to 4 boxers, 2 coaches up to 9 boxers, 3 coaches up to 13 boxers</li> </ul>
<b>RHYTHMIC GYMNASTICS</b>	<p>Maximum number of gymnasts: <b>10</b></p> <p>Maximum number of coaches: <b>2</b></p> <p>Maximum number of judges: <b>1</b></p> <p>Divided as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Group competition: 5 gymnasts, 1 substitute, 1 coach</li> <li>• Individual competition: 4 gymnasts, 1 coach</li> <li>• Each country can choose to take part in the team competition only</li> <li>• Each country can choose to take part in the individual competition only</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Each country can choose to take part in both competitions for the general country classification given by the sum of the score of the group plus the score of the 2 best gymnasts in the general individual classification (Competition I).</li> </ul> <p><b>Judges</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Judges shall be designated by ISF Member Federation in accordance with the LOC and with the ISF Technical Commission for Rhythmic Gymnastics.</li> <li>All judges must hold a valid FIG brevet.</li> <li>The judges' competence shall be guaranteed by the responsible for competition.</li> <li>The designation of judges shall be approved by a representative of the ISF Technical Commission for Rhythmic Gymnastics.</li> <li>In accordance with ISF rules, failure to provide a judge will lead to a fine of 900€ to be paid to the LOC prior to the competitions.</li> </ul>
<b>KARATE</b>	<p><b>Maximum number of karatekas: 15</b></p> <p>Maximum number of coaches: 4</p> <p>Divided as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Boys kumite: max 1 karateka per weight category; 1 coach</li> <li>Girls kumite: max 1 karateka per weight category; 1 coach</li> <li>Boys kata: max 3 karatekas; 1 coach</li> <li>Girls kata: max 3 karatekas; 1 coach</li> </ul>
