# ABOUT ISF BEACH VOLLEYBALL

ISF World School Championships (WSC) are events characterised by a balanced programme between sport and educational content: the balance between sport and education is to create awareness about the role of sport in putting forward topics such as fair play, healthy lifestyle, respect, and inclusion.

WSC Beach Volleyball is open to the participation of school and selected teams. Beside the name of the respective member, teams will defend the colours and name of the specific school they represent. This format is meant to create a strong sense of identity between the students and the school they attend.

WSC Beach Volleyball is a team competition, meaning that team results are awarded by trophies, medals and certificates. Each ISF member may enter the WSC Beach Volleyball with more than one school team per category. School Sport Entities or schools from School Sport Entities that are not members of the ISF can take a part in ISF events provided that they follow all ISF regulations and that the institutions that wish to enter the event are recognised by an official national or sport authority.

Age categories for WSC's are outlined in their respective sport-specific rules. The educational programme and the sport format of the event shall always be adapted to the age of participants: in general, in events for lower age categories, the educational content will have a more prominent role.

# **ABOUT BAT YAM, ISRAEL**

Bat Yam is a city located on Israel's Mediterranean Coast, on the central coastal strip just a tenminute drive south of Tel Aviv. 

## **VENUES**

#### **BEACHES**

The event venues will take place on Bat-Yam's beautiful golden beach, which is perhaps the greatest asset of this city. Less crowded than the Tel Aviv Beach, Bat-Yam's beach is equally impressive, and has a wide array of great activities for everyone – from surfing and windsurfing, to sailing, kayaking, and snorkelling. If the water isn't your thing, but you are still a thrill seeker, get a different perspective of Bat-Yam by going paragliding or parachuting and seeing the city, and the wider Israeli Coastal Plain from high above. There are also a great selection of less extreme activities to take part in, including, free activities on the beach throughout the summer including beach volleyball, tai-chi, Chi-kung, body building, gymnastics, yoga, Nordic walking, and the Israeli classic, Matkot (beach tennis).

# OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONY

#### **BAT YAM AMPHITHEATER**

The amphitheatre, one of the most recognisable symbols of Bat Yam will host the opening ceremony. Established in the early 1960s at the end of Independence Avenue, near the sea, as an open amphitheatre, and used for urban performances. It later became an indoor amphitheatre, with a glowing metal roof.

The amphitheatre has 4,500 seats, of which 1,000 are chairs and another 3,500 are seated on the grass.



Sunset Beach Recreation Center is located on the shoreline of Bat Yam, in the south of the promenade, area and it will host the closing ceremony.

The complex has a variety of shops, and restaurants facing the sea that combine options for entertainment and sports activities.

On the promenade, there are walking paths, advanced beach services, decorative wooden pergolas and facilities for leisure and sports games: beach volleyball courts and beach soccer fields.

For the convenience of bathers, new toilets and changing rooms are equipped with storage facilities and a place to rent equipment for recreational and beach activities. A complex of restaurants, buffets and cafes will also be established in the area for the enjoyment of the residents.





## **NATIONS NIGHT**

#### **BAT YAM CULTURE HALL**

Nations night will take place in the Bat Yam Culture Hall.

The Bat Yam Culture Hall offers a multi-purpose hall with high acoustic quality with full accessibility for the disabled and hearing disabilities.

In the Culture Hall there is free and ample parking, the hall is very close to the big highway Ayalon lanes, which allows quick access for those coming from outside Bat Yam, there is a 575 seats in the hall. The main activity of the Bat Yam Culture Hall is the subscription factory, which numbers about 5,000 people.

#### **PORTS OF ENTRY**

The followings are the official ports of entry:

#### **TRAVELING**

Travel to and from the Port of Entry is to be arranged and financed by each participating ISF member. The LOC will then arrange all transportation to and from the Port of Entry. When the distance between the host city and the capital of a participating ISF member on another continent exceeds 5000km, the delegation may extend its stay by arriving one day earlier or leaving one day later at the standard daily fee. Delegations are to arrive on May 16, 2023 and depart on May 23,2023 after breakfast. The organisation of an extended stay for the delegation (before or after the event) is a matter for the ISF member concerned. It shall not be the responsibility of the Local Organising Committee (LOC).

#### **VISA**

Please check if the members of your delegation require a visa to enter Israel.

#### INSURANCE

Each ISF member is required to provide insurance for each member of its delegation. At a minimum the insurance is to cover civil liability, material damage and medical costs.

#### **MEASURES RELATED TO COVID-19**

Due to the pandemic of COVID-19, the organising committee is placing special emphasis on the sanitary conditions in place for the health and safety of all participants operating in accordance with the guidelines of the Ministry of Health, the Ministry of Education and the ISF.

#### SECURITY AND SAFETY

The Local organising committee is always committed to organising the ISF World Beach Volleyball Championship in complete security and safety for all participants.

The city of Bat-Yam is located next to the large city of Tel Aviv just south of it. Bat-Yam has a sandy and beautiful beach and is a calm and safe area in all respects.

The organising committee operates under the guidelines of the Israel Police, the Security and Safety Division of the Ministry of Education and the Security Division of the City of Bat-Yam. The championship events will be secured according to the guidelines of the Israel Police and by professional security guards. Only authorised persons will be able to enter the various events.

The organising committee is taking every effort to provide the maximum security and safety to all participants of the event.

#### **Team format**

<u>School team</u>: a team formed by student athletes enrolled in the same school in the same country which they represent.

<u>Selected team</u>: a team formed by student athletes that can be enrolled in different schools in the same country which they represent

#### Maximum team per delegation

Per gender category: 3 teams per school category and 1 team per selected category

#### **Participation**

This event is open to the participation of:

- ISF members: Schools Sport Entities recognised as such by the General Assembly and in order with their rights and obligations;
- Non-ISF members: highest institution responsible for school sport recognized by the government of a country that is not member of ISF:
- Directly applying schools (DAS): Directly applying schools can either be:
  - A school not affiliated to an ISF member;
  - A school affiliated to an ISF member but not registering through this ISF member.

#### Participants obligations:

- Each participant is required to be present throughout the whole duration of the event.
- Each participant is obliged to take part in all the non-sport activities.
- Each team undertakes to compete against all other participating teams.
- Each participant undertakes to compete against all other participants.
- The absence of any member of a participating team from any part of the entire sport, opening, prize-giving and closing ceremonies and socio-cultural programme may result in the team's being excluded exclusion from the final results.

The championship will be held in 4 different categories:

- School Girls
- School Boys
- Selected Girls
- Selected Boys

### **COMPOSITION OF DELEGATION**

# Each delegation may enter up to 3 school teams and 1 selected team

A delegation may enter a maximum of 8 teams (3 teams per category for school teams and 1 team per selected category). Every team must be composed of a minimum of 2 students. A third (reserve) student per team can be registered: the team has no obligation to field the reserve during the tournament. In any case, no substitution shall be allowed during a match. Each competitor may only compete in one team. Mixed teams are not allowed.

#### **EACH DELEGATION SHALL CONSISTS OF:**

- 1. Head of delegation mandatory;
- 2. Athlete(s) mandatory;
- 3. Team official(s)
  - a) Coaches mandatory
- 4. Referees optional;
- 5.Additional adults optional;

#### **HEAD OF DELEGATION**

There is a mandatory number of one (1) head of delegation per registering delegation.

- HoD shall be the main intermediary between the delegation and the Local Organising Committee, the ISF Technical Commission and the ISF Delegate.
- They may not combine their role of HoD with that of a coach or any other official role.
- Each delegation is entitled to enter 1 HoD.

#### **ATHLETES**

- Each team will be consit of minimum 2 athletes and maximum 3 athletes.
- A third (reserve) student per team can be registered: the team has no obligation to field the reserve during the tournament. In any case, no substitution shall be allowed during a match.
- Athletes must be enrolled as full-time students at a school in the country which they
  represent.
- All athletes must be attending schools which provide a general education.
- The following are not eligible to participate:
  - The following are not eligible to participate:
  - Attendees of vocational schools who only attend a school as a complement to their vocational training and are not full-time students with segment of general education.
  - Students enrolled at schools which provide sports training without any general education.
  - Part-time (e.g. afternoon) sports schools which take pupils from a variety of schools for training in one or more sports.
  - Teams formed as part of clubs, companies, or other institutions.

#### **TEAM OFFICIALS**

#### **COACHES**

- The presence of a 1 coach per team is mandatory.
- Teams cannot participate in the competition without the presence of a coach.

#### **REFEREE (OPTIONAL):**

 Each participating delegation can nominate one or two referees with a national or international ranking. These referees must be able to umpire in English.

#### **ADDITIONAL ADULTS**

The function of each additional adult must be specified during the registration process (interpreter, security personnel, ministry representative, media, etc.). Delegations can register up to 4 additional adults.

Any other person not specified during registration or exceeding the quotas specified in this document will not be considered part of the official delegation and will not be accredited by the LOC.

## **TECHNICAL RULES**

The competition will be run according to current ISF and FIVB rules under the direction of the ISF Technical Commission for Beach Volleyball.

## **DISCIPLINARY MANAGMENT**

#### **EVENT DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION**

In accordance with the ISF General Competition Rules, The ISF Event Disciplinary Commission shall deal with all incidents and all violations of the ISF Statutes, Sport Policy, ISF Handbook, Rules, and any other ISF document linked to the ISF events and broadly with misbehavior not directly related to the sport technical regulation during an ISF event.

#### **APPEAL JURY**

The Appeal Jury shall deal with all protests of a technical sporting nature during the competition.

The Appeal Jury is composed by the President of the Technical Commission, one member of the Local Organising Committee, and the Head Field of Play Officials.

#### **ANTI-DOPING**

ISF being a Wada code signatory is promoting clean sport as one of the main values applied during its events. Besides the tests than can take place accordingly to the age category and the tradition of relevant sports, ISF in cooperation with WADA is implementing a large educational programme to raise awareness on the danger of doping behaviours.

The registration process for ISF members is divided in 2 phases:

Phase 1 / deposit payment
July 20, 2022 to December 10, 2022

Registration phase 1 for the ISF WSC Beach Volleyball 2023 shall be from July 20 2022 to December 10, 2022. During registration phase 1 registering delegations shall indicate their intention of participation, the number of teams per category that they wish to enter and exact number of participants per team. All ISF members are expected to pay the deposits for their teams or reach an agreement with the ISF (see chapter below) by December, 20 2022. Delegation will be able to enter Registration phase 2 after the \*deposit has been paid or an agreement with the ISF has been reached but no later than December 10, 2022.

<u>Phase 2</u> <u>December 11, 2022 – February 16, 2023</u>

In registration phase 2, countries are expected to enter the exact detailed information for each participant (name, date of birth, gender, photo, dietary requirements). Furthermore, delegation will submit their expected date of arrival and departure as well as the type of transport that will be required. Registration phase 2 will be open till February 16, 2023.

## **Financial Conditions**

To participate, each ISF member is required to make two (2) payments:

- 1. Deposit payment
- 2. Balance fee payment



#### 1. Deposit payment

Along with the entry and in order to have access to the second registration phase, participating ISF members will need to pay a deposit of 500€ per team entered. The sum will be deducted from the total participation cost. The deposit is non-refundable in the event of non-participation. Waivers to the payment of the deposit (ISF agreement), for whatever reasons, are to be discussed with the ISF office and to be agreed by the deposit payment deadlines.

#### 2. Balance fee payment

The balance fee payment is the participation fee minus the deposit which has already been paid.

#### Participation fee
