ERZURUM

It is located on the Atatürk University campus, below Erzurum. It is proposed to use the existing 3200 bed capacity student dormitory built for the 2011 Winter University Games.

As Athlete Village, it is planned to use a dormitory building with 262 rooms and 1034 beds consisting of two blocks. In the village of Athlete, there is an event area, a dining hall for 500 people, a market, a conference hall for 250 people, and 7 meeting rooms for 25 people.













Food and Bevarages

Accredited persons will receive 3 meals per day:

- Breakfast
- Lunch
- Dinner

All meals will be supplied by a catering company and will be served in the Athletes' Village.

Dependant on the competition schedule, catering services will be available at the completion venues.

Water will be provided for all accredited persons during meals.

During the sport activities (training or official competitions), water bottles will always be provided at competition sites.



All equipment to be FIS approved for athletes competing under FIS licenses. Other necessary elements and equipment for competition may be used at the discretion of the LOC, as long as it does not conflict with ISF rules or the FIS ICR.

All equipment (course, competition, clothing, and weaponry) are to be IBU approved.

All equipment to be FIS approved for athletes competing under FIS licenses. Other necessary elements and equipment for competition may be used at the discretion of the LOC, as long as it does not conflict with ISF rules or the FIS ICR.

Sheet dimensions and rocks are to be WCF approved.

All equipment (skating, competition, and clothing) are to be ISU approved.

All equipment to be FIS approved for athletes competing under FIS licenses. Other necessary elements and equipment for competition may be used at the discretion of the LOC, as long as it does not conflict with ISF rules or the FIS ICR.

Snow Sport Preparation

Wax cabins, waxing and ski maintenance tables will be provided by the Local Organising Committee to the countries in the competition area, except snowboarding which will be available in the Athletes' Village, where a common area and table support will be provided for ski maintenance and waxing. All other needed equipment should be brought by the countries.

Important to note that according to FIS regulations, FLUOR is NOT permitted.

Disicplinary Managment

Event Discplinary Commission

In accordance with the ISF General Competition Rules, The ISF Event Disciplinary Commission shall deal with all incidents and all violations of the ISF Statutes, Sports Policy, ISF Handbook, Rules, and any other ISF document linked to the ISF events and broadly with misbehaviors not directly related to the sport technical regulation during an ISF event.

The Commission is composed of the ISF Delegate, the Sports Committee Chair and LOC Delegate.

Appeal jury

The Appeal Jury shall deal with all protests of a technical sporting nature during the competition. The Appeal Jury is formed for all sports in the ISF Winter Gymnasiade Erzurum 2023 and is composed of the Chair of the ISF Technical Commission concerned, one member of the Local Organising Committee, the Head Field of Play Officials.

Anti doping

Anti-doping tests may take place during the Event.

ISF being a Wada code signatory is promoting clean sport as one of the main values applied during its events. Besides the tests than can take place accordingly to the age category and the tradition of relevant sports, ISF in cooperation with WADA is implementing a large educational programme to raise awareness on the danger of doping behaviours.

ISF Academy



Created in December 2022, the ISF Academy is the new educational center of the International School Sport Federation delivering online and onsite capacity-building activities for teachers, school sports representatives, coaches, officials, and students around the world. It aims to recognize and or to upgrade the knowledge and skills of any of these stakeholders involved or planning to be involved in national, continental, or international sports, educational networks, institutions, events, or organisation.

The mission of this body is to design and deliver short-, mid-, and long-term quality education and capacity-building activities for physical education teachers, national school sport representatives, coaches, officials, and students around the world. These educational programmes will be held online on the ISF Academy platform prior to the events and particularly during the organisation of ISF events on-site, after the competition hours.

Therefore, before and during this international ISF event, heads of delegation, coaches, referees, international school athletes, and local school students will have the opportunity to take part in various interactive educational activities on different topics



HEAD OF DELEGATION AND COACHES PROGRAMME



The ISF Academy will organise an online webinar, a few weeks before the event to support the Head of Delegation and Coaches in preparing their mission within an ISF event. These online educational & capacity building activities are compulsory to attend for all the following adults' stakeholders taking part in ISF events:

- 1) Heads of Delegation (Compulsory)
- 2) Deputy Head of Delegation (if any and if the delegation request it)
- 3) Assistant to the Head of Delegation (if any and if the delegation request it)
- 4) Coaches (Compulsory)

The programme will be composed of different modules related to the ISF, the Organising Committee, and several crucial subjects related to Safeguarding in Sports, Anti-Doping, and Diplomacy in Sport. Other topics might be added as well.

Any adults having key responsibilities towards, the ISF, the Local Organising Committee, and ultimately school students within an ISF international event shall be taking part in this crucial educational programme which will contribute to supporting these adults in their duty and mission before, during, and after the event.

Important: The head of the delegation and the coaches will have to participate in the complete training programme to be authorized to receive accreditation for the event.

More than twenty (20) international and national organisations will gather aiming to raise awareness on the Olympic values, to discover traditional or innovative sports, and to discover the culture of the different participating countries. Cultural Activities

The cultural visits will take place on 16th February 2023.

For the Cultural Activities, there will be a programme put in place by the LOC, which will be communicated with participants prior to the event.

Erzurum Double Minaret Madrasa:

The Double Minaret Madrasa is a Seljuk work that has become the symbol of Erzurum. It is generally accepted that it was built at the end of the 13th century. It is also called the Hatuniye Madrasa, with the thought that it may have been built by Hundi Hatun, the daughter of the Seljuk Sultan Alaaddin Keykubat, or by Sultan Hatun from the Ilkhanid Dynasties.



Erzurum Castle:

The history of Erzurum Castle dates back to about 2,500 years ago, to the Urartians, who dominated the region. The first version of the inner castle, which still exists today, was built by the Byzantine Emperor Theodosius in 415. Erzurum Castle consists of the inner castle, where the guard soldiers are located, and the outer castle, which includes the streets, streets and neighborhoods where the people reside.

Erzurum Ice Museum:

At the Ata Ice Museum, which has the only ice museum in Turkey within the Atatürk University campus, newly made ice sculptures await its enthusiasts. Ata Ice Museum, where interesting ice artifacts are exhibited, can be visited free of charge. The ice stove and Semaver warm the visitors.



Cultural Activities

Nations Night

The Nations Night encourages exchanges between the different cultures of the participating countries.

During the Nation Night, each delegation is entitled to have a booth to present themselves, in a fair atmosphere. Delegations are free to bring any material for presenting themselves over the booth.

The Nation Night is set to be on the 16th February, at the Athletes' Village from 17h00 to 21h00.

Nations who so wish, will be able to go on stage to present a typical dance of their country. If nations want to take part in this animation, please report to the LOC and provide music in MP3 format by naming the file "nameofcountry.songtitle.MP3"



Accreditation

- The Accreditation Center will be located in the Athletes village.
- Heads of Delegations will be taken to the accreditation point and will require all necessary documents from their registration: passports, insurance papers, school certificate(s), and consent forms.
- The accreditation centre will be open all day long on 10th 11th February 2023.
- An identification document must be presented to get the accreditations
- A temporary identification system will be put in place in case the normative accreditations need to be changed
- Accreditations will be issued by sport, by delegation, and by function At the Accreditation Center, the Head of Delegation must be present. He/she can be accompanied by a coach or by an additional adult. No other member of the delegation shall be admitted to the accreditation room.

At accreditation, the following *documents will be checked:

- 1. Valid ID/passport: The passport (or ID card) bearing the family name, first name, photograph, nationality and date of birth of each member of the delegation. Please note that copies or scans of the ID/passports will not be accepted
- 2. Proof of payment: proof of payment of the balance including any bank charges. To help the ISF correctly process your payment, please complete the "payment overview" form and send it to the ISF by e-mail prior to your arrival at the event. A payment Overview will be sent to all delegations in the coming days. Registered countries will be informed on when and how to deliver proof of payment documents

Reminder: All documents must be uploaded to the ISF ERAS Registration platform, no later than the 25th of January 2023.

Documents to be uploaded to ERAS:

- 1. ISF Consent Form: the use of image and anti-doping consent form of each participant, signed by the competitor's parent or legal guardian if he/she is a minor.
- 2.ISF School Certificate: the ISF School Certificate form signed by the legitimate School Sport Entity, confirms that all athletes are full-time students in school since the beginning of the school year.
- 3. Insurance: the document certifying that the delegation is covered by insurance. At a minimum, the insurance is to cover civil liability, material damage and medical costs.

Accreditations cards will be handed to the Head of Delegation at the end of the process, once all documents have been checked.

Please note, that the accreditation process may be subject to change. Any relevant changes will be communicated to the registering delegation prior to the event.


ISF Levy




