All hotels are following similar standards and 3 hot meal per day will be served in the hotels. Meals schedule will be fixed according to the sport program.


Delegations will be accommodated together at the same hotel

# TRANSPORTATION

---




- There will be schedule bus service according to the sport program and other non sport activities.
- A designated board will be placed at the hotel where all information will be published daily.
- Bus services will be used for various purposes, including transportation to training and competition venues, arrivals and departures, as well as for attending the opening and closing ceremonies. Additionally, it will be available for cultural and educational activities.



## CULTURAL DAY

- The Cultural day will be done in the middle of competition on 24th of April
- There will be schedule visit of all participants to beautiful Belgrade Fortress. The visit will be followed by tourist guides for one and a half hour.
- Transport and groups will be published in lobby of hotels one day before.

The Nations' Night promotes cultural exchanges between participating countries by offering each delegation the opportunity to have a stand where it can present itself in a spirit of fairness. Delegations are free to bring whatever material they need to showcase their culture on their stand.

## SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN IN SPORT & ANTIDOPING WORKSHOPS

As well as various webinars taking place several days before the event to support the Head of Delegation and Coaches in preparing their mission within an ISF event (these online educational & capacity building activities are compulsory to attend for all the following adults' stakeholders taking part in ISF events), the ISF's promotion of school sport by the ISF Academy through its international events also involves the transmission of knowledge through workshops on two themes that are dear to us all: **Safeguarding Children in Sport** and **Doping Prevention in Sport**. ISF firmly believes that children have and must have the necessary inner resources, through these workshops, to understand, identify and react to negative behaviour such as racism, gender inequality or violence and abuse. The challenge for ISF is to find the right way to express difficult ideas and present complicated topics to young people so that they understand, but also so that they correctly apprehend this problem and are able to react to it.

Raising awareness and enabling participants to transfer their knowledge to their peers back home are also key elements of ISF. During this event, athletes from all over the world will attend several workshops sessions given by experts in the field, passing on their knowledge and experience through dedicated, constructive and interactive pedagogy.

**Safeguarding and Anti-doping** seminars will be organized on **21st, 22nd and 23rd of April** in the afternoon hours in the hotel conference halls.

# FINANCIAL CONDITIONS



## BALANCE FEE PAYMENT

**Balance fee payment = Participation fee - Deposit** (*already paid*)

The balance fee payment is to be paid before the start of the event to the LOC account (all bank charges are to be met by the participating delegation).

### *Participation fee*

The participation fee covers full board accommodation for the duration of the event plus competition, cultural programme activities and all local transport from the arrival to the official port of entry to the departure of the team.

The participation fee is composed of:

1. **Rates by night:** minimum 60€/night/delegation member
2. **ISF levy:**
  - 100€ per person (ISF members)
  - 150€ per person (non-ISF members)




## GOOD TO KNOW


### SERBIA TRAVEL ADAPTORS

You will need to consider what to pack, to ensure you can use your personal electrical appliances safely whilst abroad. This normally includes the use of a travel adaptor, which is a device that simply allows you to plug any electrical appliance into a foreign electrical socket. It is important to note that it does not convert the voltage or frequency.

For Serbia there are two associated plug types, types C and F. Plug type C is the plug which has two round pins and plug type F is the plug which has two round pins with two earth clips on the side. Serbia operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz.
