

ABOUT ISF WSC


ISF World School Championships (WSC) are events characterized by a balanced program between sport and educational content: the balance between sport and education is to create awareness about the role of sports in putting forward topics such as fair play, healthy lifestyle, respect, and inclusion.

The educational program and the sport format of the event shall always be adapted to the age of participants.

WSC is open to the participation of all students attending a school that provides general education and/or vocational education incorporating segments of general education.

WSC is a team competition, meaning that team results are awarded by trophies, medals, and certificates. Each delegation may enter the competition with more than one team per category.

ABOUT SHANGLUO

A STRATEGIC HUB FOR SPORTS AND ECOLOGY

Strategically located in southeastern Shaanxi at the Qinling Mountains' foothills, Shangluo spans 19,300 km² with 2.46 million residents. Shangluo is China's crucial north-south ecological barrier serving as a key water source for the South-to-North Water Diversion Project while preserving exceptional biodiversity. This historic trade corridor now exemplifies sustainable development through its forest-based green economy and eco-tourism initiatives, balancing environmental protection with regional connectivity.

As a cradle of Chinese civilization, Shangluo features natural wonders like Jinsixia Grand Canyon (5A-rated) and Zhashui Karst Caves, alongside historic Manchuan Ancient Town.

With 69.56% forest coverage, the city has become a green economy leader in biopharmaceuticals and eco-tourism. Its pristine environment and mild climate make it ideal for both wellness tourism and outdoor sports training, offering exceptional terrain for endurance athletics.

Shangluo's unique combination of ecological assets and sports potential positions it as a premier destination for competitive training and sustainable development.



ABOUT SHANGLUO

JINSIXIA GRAND CANYON

Officially designated as a National 5A-level Tourist Attraction, Jinsixia Grand Canyon holds multiple prestigious titles including National Geological Park, National Forest Park, and National Water Conservancy Scenic Area.

The scenic area boasts a unique micro climate where visitors can experience "three seasons in one day." Its breathtaking landscape features a "Ten-Mile Orchid Fragrance Trail," offering an immersive floral experience a midst pristine natural surroundings.





NIUBEILIANG NATIONAL FOREST PARK

As a national 4A - level scenic area in the heart of the Qinling Mountains' eastern range, Niubeiliang showcases pristine forest ecosystems with complete vertical vegetation zones. Ancient fir forests, alpine rhododendrons and glacial relics create spectacular natural vistas. With 91% forest coverage, year- round temperatures averaging 12 °C and over 50,000 negative oxygen ions/cm³, it's acclaimed as the "Qinling Natural Oxygen Bar." This biodiversity hot spot serves as a vital base for ecological research, geological studies and environmental education.


ABOUT SHANGLUO

QINLING MUSEUM

Covering a total area of 7.24 hectares with a floor space of 43,788 square meters, the Qinling Museum features an innovative "Mountain-Water-Jade" architectural concept. Its strikingdesign includes:

A 40-meter-high glass atrium inspired by the Shang Dynasty oracle bone script character for "wine vessel". A multi-functional rooftopspace combining urban terrace and performance arena. Terrain-hugging architecture seamlessly integrated with the surrounding landscape. As Shangluo's first integrated museum complex (combining Qinling Natural History Museum and Shangluo Historical Museum), its collections include:

- Historical artifacts: Neolithic tools, pottery, bronze ware, jade carvings, porcelain
- Natural specimens: Geological formations, biological samples
- Modern historical witnesses

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

PARTICIPATION

There is NO limit to the number of teams per gender, by delegation

The following students may take part in the ISF events as part of the team :

- The students are enrolled as full-time students at a school in the country in which they represent.
- The student-athletes must be attending schools that provide general education and/or vocational education incorporating segments of general education.
- Only the students registered on the team list that was handed in at accreditation are authorized to take part in this competition.

The following are not eligible to participate:

- Attendees of vocational schools only attend school as a complement to their vocational training and are not full-time students with a segment of general education.
- Students enrolled at schools that provide sports training without any general education.

Each delegation may enter more than 1 team per gender category.

SPORT

COMPOSITION OF DELEGATION

Each delegation shall consists of:

- 1. Head of delegation mandatory
- 2. Student athlete(s) mandatory
- 3. Team officials (Coaches/Other Team Officials) mandatory
- 4. Field of Play Officials (referees/umpires/judges) mandatory
- 5. Additional adults optional
- 6. Safeguarding officer optional
- 7. Delegation media staff optional
- 8. National Authority optional

HEAD OF THE DELEGATION

There is a mandatory amount of one (1) head of the delegation per registering delegation.

The head of the delegation shall be the sole intermediary between the delegation the Local Organising Committee, and the ISF.

He/she may not combine the function with any other official role (i.e., coach, referee, etc.).

STUDENT-ATHLETES

Each team consists of a minimum of 8 and maximum of 14 athletes.

Only the students registered on the team list that was handed in at accreditation are authorized to take part in this competition.

COACHES

Each delegation shall bring a minimum of 1 coach per team

- The coach shall manage the team in the competition
- The presence of coaches is mandatory

OTHER TEAM OFFICIALS

- The function of other team officials can be doctors, trainers, physiotherapists, statisticians, team managers, etc.)
- The function of each other team officials must be specified during the registration process

SPORT

COMPOSITION OF DELEGATION

FIELD OF PLAY OFFICIALS - FOPO (REFEREES)

- Each delegation shall enter one (1) field of play official (referee) per team registered.
- The Field of play officials cannot combine their position with other positions, such as heads of delegation, team officials, or additional adults.
- Field of play officials (referees) must accept the possibility they might be in the referee or assistant referee position at the event matches.
- Field of play officials (referees) shall be in possession of international (FIVB) or national qualification.
- The qualification will be reviewed and approved by the ISF Volleyball Technical Commission.
 Delegations must provide certificates for the field of play officials during the registration process.
- Failure to provide the required number of field of play officials (referees) will lead to a fine of 900€ (per referee).

ADDITIONAL ADULTS

The function of each additional adult must be specified during the registration process (interpreter, security personnel, ministry representative, media, etc.).

SAFEGUARDING OFFICER

An optional role for each delegation. Safeguarding officers shall have the ability to identify situations which cause concern to the safety and wellbeing of youth during events.

DELEGATION MEDIA STAFF

National media staff support delegations by managing media coverage, coordinating press interactions, and ensuring key messages are communicated effectively during events

NATIONAL AUTHORITY

The function of each national authority must be specified during the registration process (government representative, ministry representative, etc.).

SPORT

TECHNICAL RULES

The competition will be run according to current **ISF** and **FIVB rules**. The detailed rules and regulations for the competition you can find it **HERE**.

DISCIPLINARY MANAGEMENT

EVENT DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION

The ISF Event Disciplinary Commission shall deal with all incidents and all violations of the ISF Statutes, Sport Policy, ISF Handbook, Rules, and any other ISF document linked to the ISF events and broadly with misbehavior not directly related to the sport technical regulation during an ISF event.

The Event Disciplinary Commission is composed of the ISF Delegate, the TC Volleyball President, and the LOC President.

APPEAL JURY

The Appeal Jury shall deal with all protests of a technical sporting nature during the competition.

The Appeal Jury is composed of the President of the Technical Commission, one member of the Local Organising Committee, and the Head Field of Play Officials.

APPEALS

Information about the appeals will be communicated within ISF Technical Rules and Regulations of Volleyball.

SPORT

OBLIGATIONS

PARTICIPANTS OBLIGATIONS

- All participants must be present for the entire duration of the event, from arrival to departure as stated in the official programme.
- Participation in all non-sport activities is mandatory.
- Each team must compete against all other teams.
- Each participant must compete against all other participants.
- Any absence from the sports programme, ceremonies (opening, prize-giving, closing), or socio-cultural activities may lead to the team's disqualification.
- Delegations must stay in official event accommodation provided by the LOC to participate in the event.

ANTI-DOPING

The ISF, together with WADA, promotes clean sport as one of the core values upheld during its events. Doping control may be conducted in accordance with the World Anti-Doping Code and the International Standards for Testing and Investigations (ISTI), taking into account the age category and the risk assessment of the relevant sports. In cooperation with WADA, the ISF also implements a preventive education programme aimed at raising awareness of the risks and consequences of doping.







ISF ACADEMY



The ISF Academy is the educational center of the International School Sport Federation delivering online and onsite capacity-building activities for teachers, school sports representatives, coaches, officials, and students around the world. It aims to recognize and or to upgrade the knowledge and skills of any of these stakeholders involved or planning to be involved in national, continental, or international sports, educational networks, institutions, events, or organisation.

The mission of this body is to design and deliver short-, mid-, and long-term quality education and capacity-building activities for students, physical education teachers, national school sport representatives, coaches and officials around the world. These educational programmes will be held online on the ISF Academy platform prior to the events and particularly during the organisation of ISF events on-site, after the competition hours.

Therefore, before and during this international ISF event, heads of delegation, coaches, referees, international school athletes, and local school students will have the opportunity to take part in various interactive educational activities on different topics.





ISF ACADEMY

HEADS OF DELEGATION AND COACHES PROGRAMME

The ISF Academy will organise an online webinar, a few weeks before the event to support the Head of Delegation, Coaches in preparing their mission within an ISF event. These online educational & capacity building activities are compulsory to attend for all the following adults' stakeholders taking part in ISF events:

- 1. Heads of Delegation Compulsory
- 2. Coaches Compulsory

The programme will be composed of different modules related to the ISF, the Organising Committee, and several crucial subjects related to Safeguarding Children in Sport, Anti-Doping, and Diplomacy in Sport. Other topics might be added as well.



Any adults having key responsibilities towards, the ISF, the Local Organising Committee, and ultimately school students within an ISF international event shall be taking part in this crucial educational programme which will contribute to supporting these adults in their duty and mission before, during, and after the event.

IMPORTANT

The head of the delegation and the coaches will have to participate in the complete training programme to be authorized to receive accreditation for the event.

Note: The Head of Delegations and Coaches will be informed in due time of the dates of the online webinar. The detail programme of this webinar as well.

After each online workshop, participants will receive a link to complete assessments. To validate their certificate of completion, each participant must have a minimum of 50% success rate to all the assessments before receiving the certificate.

SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN IN SPORT & ANTIDOPING WORKSHOPS

As well as various webinars taking place several days before the event to support the Head of Delegation and Coaches in preparing their mission within an ISF event (these online educational & capacity building activities are compulsory to attend for all the following adults' stakeholders taking part in ISF events), the ISF's promotion of school sport by the ISF Academy through its international events also involves the transmission of knowledge through workshops on three themes that are dear to us all: **Safeguarding Children in Sport** and **Doping Prevention in Sport** and **Injury prevention**.

ISF firmly believes that children have and must have the necessary inner resources, through these workshops, to understand, identify and react to negative behaviour such as racism, gender inequality or violence and abuse. The challenge for ISF is to find the right way to express difficult ideas and present complicated topics to young people so that they understand, but also so that they correctly apprehend this problem and are able to react to it.

Raising awareness and enabling participants to transfer their knowledge to their peers back home are also key elements of ISF. During this event, athletes from all over the world will attend several workshops sessions given by experts in the field, passing on their knowledge and experience through dedicated, constructive and interactive pedagogy.



ISF ACADEMY

PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHERS SEMINAR

Whoever said that acquiring knowledge and skills is reserved only for the youth?

The ISF Academy has recently taken on another challenge: to train Physical Education teachers, enhancing their skills and giving them the best tools to promote sports within the school environment. During the event, the ISF Academy, in partnership with International Sports Federation and/or the LOC, will organise workshops for national PE Teachers aiming at providing pedagogical tools and innovative exercises to better engage young individuals in sports and develop life skills through the sport. This activities will be open to any PE Teachers as well.









ISF ACADEMY

FUN & SKILLS ZONE

The Fun and Skill Zone concept aims to provide the participants athletes, coaches and the local young participants with an open area where a variety of educational, physical, and cultural activities are proposed on the daily basis. ISF Academy educational and national organisations& partner booths will gather aiming to raise awareness on the Olympic values and art, to discover traditional or innovative sports, and to discover the culture of the different participating countries/regions. Participants will have the occasion to participate in activities with all our International Sports Federations partners, with our safeguarding Children, Doping prevention, mental health, physiology and kinesiology experts (complex core).

It will be the heart of the event. The place where the different delegations can meet, learn, discuss and get to know each other better.



REGISTRATION

HOW TO REGISTER

The **only** recognised method of registration is through **ERAS** - the ISF official registration platform.

Within the platform there will be 2 sections of registration:

- for ISF members
- for Non-ISF members

Please select the appropriate section related to your registration type.

Each ISF member is automatically entitled to have their own credentials to access ERAS. For non-ISF members registration, access will be provided following submission of information through this initial step.

Registration to the Event will be divided into 2 phases:

PHASE 1: Sign Up

Registration will be done through the official ISF registration system ERAS. Participating delegations will be required to register their members and make Deposit payments.

Information to be entered in:

- The exact number of teams and athletes (boys/girls), coaches, FOPO and additional adults;
- Name, birth date, gender, and passport copy.

PHASE 2: Collecting data & information

Delegations are expected to enter the exact detailed information:

- Final detailed information for each participant (photo, dietary requirements, personal bests, jersey number)
- Upload all needed documents online
- Submitting the expected date of arrival and departure, and type of transport
- Rooming list
- Payment overview
- All other relevant document

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

To participate, each ISF member is required to make two (2) payments:

- 1. Deposit payment
- 2. Balance fee payment

DEPOSIT PAYMENT

Along with the entry and in order to have access to registration phase 2, participating in ISF members will need to pay a deposit of 1800 € per team registered in Phase 1.

Please note that participation in the event is granted only by a deposit payment. Deadline of deposit payment: April 1, 2026

- The sum will be deducted from the total participation cost.
- The deposit must be sent as a single payment for the whole delegation by the organization responsible for school sports (federation, trust, ministry...).
- The deposit is non-refundable in the event of non-participation. Waivers to the payment
 of the deposit, for whatever reasons, are to be discussed with the ISF office and to be
 agreed upon before the deposit payment deadlines.

The deposit for the registered teams per category shall be paid by **April 1, 2026**. If the deposit is not paid within the given deadline, the registrations will not be considered valid and will be automatically deleted from ERAS.
