# TRANSPORTATION

Transportation will be provided for arrivals and departures between the airport and the hotel, as well as for the Cultural Day program. For all other activities, no additional transport will be required, as both sport and non-sport activities are smartly connected within the CICB complex. # **CULTURAL DAY**

The Cultural Day will be organized on 16th November, with a detailed schedule prepared for each delegation. All participants will have the opportunity to explore the main cultural and historical landmarks of Brasília, a unique city designed in the shape of an airplane and recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Delegations will discover iconic sites such as the National Congress, Palácio da Alvorada (Presidential Palace), Palácio do Planalto, and the impressive Cathedral of Brasília designed by Oscar Niemeyer. The program will also include visits to the JK Memorial, Itamaraty Palace, and a panoramic view from the TV Tower, offering a full experience of the capital's cultural and architectural identity.

This cultural journey will allow participants not only to see the highlights of Brasília but also to feel the spirit of a city built on vision, innovation, and harmony.



# **NATIONS NIGHT**

The Nations Activity promotes cultural exchanges between participating countries and regions by offering each delegation the opportunity to have a booth where it can present itself in a spirit of fairness. Delegations are free to bring whatever material they need to showcase their culture on their stand.

# **CEREMONIES**

The Opening Ceremony will take place at CICB, offering a convenient and easily accessible location for all participants. Attendance is mandatory for every delegation member, as this event marks the official start of the competition and provides a unique opportunity to celebrate together.



## **ISF ACADEMY**



The ISF Academy is the educational center of the International School Sport Federation delivering online and onsite capacity-building activities for teachers, school sports representatives, coaches, officials, and students around the world. It aims to recognize and or to upgrade the knowledge and skills of any of these stakeholders involved or planning to be involved in national, continental, or international sports, educational networks, institutions, events, or organisation.

The mission of this body is to design and deliver short-, mid-, and long-term quality education and capacity-building activities for students, physical education teachers, national school sport representatives, coaches and officials around the world. These educational programmes will be held online on the ISF Academy platform prior to the events and particularly during the organisation of ISF events on-site, after the competition hours.

Therefore, before and during this international ISF event, heads of delegation, coaches, referees, international school athletes, and local school students will have the opportunity to take part in various interactive educational activities on different topics.





# ISF ACADEMY

## HEADS OF DELEGATION AND COACHES PROGRAMME

The ISF Academy will organise an online webinar, a few weeks before the event to support the Head of Delegation, Coaches in preparing their mission within an ISF event. These online educational & capacity building activities are compulsory to attend for all the following adults' stakeholders taking part in ISF events:

- 1) Heads of Delegation (Compulsory)
- 2) Coaches (Compulsory)

The programme will be composed of different modules related to the ISF, the Organising Committee, and several crucial subjects related to Safeguarding Children in Sport, Anti-Doping, and Event Ecosystem.. Other topics might be added as well.



Any adults having key responsibilities towards, the ISF, the Local Organising Committee, and ultimately school students within an ISF international event shall be taking part in this crucial educational programme which will contribute to supporting these adults in their duty and mission before, during, and after the event.

Important: The head of the delegation and the coaches will have to participate in the complete training programme to be authorized to receive accreditation for the event.

**Note**: The Head of Delegations and Coaches will be informed in due time of the dates of the online webinar. The detail programme of this webinar as well.

After each online workshop, participants will receive a link to complete assessments. To validate their certificate of completion, each participant must have a minimum of 50% success rate to all the assessments before receiving the certificate.

# SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN IN SPORT & ANTIDOPING & INJURY PREVENTION WORKSHOPS

As well as various webinars taking place several days before the event to support the Head of Delegation and Coaches in preparing their mission within an ISF event (these online educational & capacity building activities are compulsory to attend for all the following adult stakeholders taking part in ISF events), the ISF's promotion of school sport by the ISF Academy through its international events also involves the transmission of knowledge through workshops on three themes that are dear to us all: **Safeguarding Children in Sport, Doping Prevention in Sport** and **Injury Prevention**.

ISF firmly believes that children must, through these workshops, develop the necessary inner resources to understand, identify, and react to negative behaviors such as racism, gender inequality, violence, and abuse, as well as to gain proper knowledge about doping and appropriately address mental health issues among athletes.

The challenge for ISF is to find the right way to express difficult ideas and present complicated topics to young people so that they understand, but also so that they correctly apprehend this problem and are able to react to it.

Raising awareness and enabling participants to transfer their knowledge to their peers back home are also key elements of ISF. During this event, athletes from all over the world will attend several workshop sessions given by experts in the field, passing on their knowledge and experience through dedicated, constructive, and interactive pedagogy.

Therefore, all athletes participating in ISF events are required to attend the ISF Academy's seminars on safeguarding children, anti-doping, and Injury prevention. These seminars are scheduled to take place on November 13th - 19th, in the afternoon after competition. Specific delegation time slots will be communicated during the event briefing.

#### Participation fee

The participation fee covers full board accommodation for the duration of the event plus competition, cultural programme activities and all local transport from the arrival to the official port of entry to the departure of the team.

All Heads of Delegation are expected to take part in the dinner. The gala dinner fee is 50€/person, to be paid together with the final balance.


Participation in the Gala Dinner must be declared both in the payment overview and during accreditation. Please note that once accreditation is completed, it will not be possible to add additional participants.



## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

## BRAZIL TRAVEL ADAPTORS

For Brazil there are two associated plug types, types C and N. Plug type C is the plug which has two round pins. Plug type N is the plug which has two round pins and a grounding pin. Brazil operates on a 127/220V supply voltage and 60Hz. The power supply in Brazil is 127V, however some of the newer hotels operate at 220V.



## STAY CONNECTED - ESIM IN BRAZIL

Brazil supports eSIM technology, which allows travelers to connect to mobile networks without needing a physical SIM card. With an eSIM, you can access data, make calls, and send messages directly from your smartphone, provided your device is eSIM-compatible.

Using an eSIM is convenient for tourists because it avoids the need to purchase and swap physical SIM cards. Many international eSIM providers offer short-term data plans suitable for travelers, and local Brazilian carriers also provide eSIM options for longer stays.

Before your trip, make sure your phone supports eSIM, and consider purchasing a plan that matches your data needs. Once activated, eSIMs provide reliable coverage across major cities, including Brasília, Rio de Janeiro, and São Paulo, making it easy to stay connected throughout your visit.

# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

## LOCAL TRANSPORTATION - UBER IN BRASÍLIA

Uber is available 24/7 across the city. Use the app to request rides, choosing from options like UberX, Comfort, or UberXL, and pay via the app. Typical fares for short trips within the city start around R\$10–R\$20, depending on distance and traffic.

## **CURRENCY**

#### **Brazilian Currency**

The official currency of Brazil is the Brazilian Real (BRL / R\$).

Banknotes: R\$2, R\$5, R\$10, R\$20, R\$50, R\$100, R\$200

Coins: 1, 5, 10, 25, 50 centavos and R\$1 1 Euro (EUR) = 6.25 Brazilian Reais (BRL)

#### **Payment Methods:**

Credit and debit cards (Visa, MasterCard, and American Express) are widely accepted in hotels, restaurants, and shops.

Small businesses, taxis, and local markets may prefer cash payments, so it is advisable to carry some smaller banknotes.

#### **Currency Exchange:**

Foreign currency can be exchanged at airports, banks, and authorized exchange offices ("Casa de Câmbio").

Exchange rates may vary slightly, but official exchange offices are recommended for security and reliability.

#### ATMs:

ATMs are widely available in major cities and shopping centers.

International cards (Visa, MasterCard, Cirrus, Plus) can be used, but daily withdrawal limits and fees may apply.
