COMPETITION FORMAT

The competitive structure of the first phase is determined through a draw held beforehand, defining both the number of teams per group and the countries that will be allocated to each group

BOY'S COMPETITION

13 teams divided into 3 groups

Groups A - $C \rightarrow 3$ teams Groups D \rightarrow 4 teams

1st phase: group stages, all vs all

2nd phase: Elimination rounds in quarterfinals. Cross – A vs B, C vs D → Ranking System

Day 6 finals: Men's Final at 18:00

The first phase is played in a "Round Robin system" (everyone plays each other).

The top two teams from each group qualify for the ranking from 1st to 8th place in the final standings, with Quarterfinals, Semifinals, and Finals.

The matchups will be: 1st A vs 2nd B, 1st B vs 2nd A, 1st C vs 2nd D, and 1st D vs 2nd C.

The third-placed teams and the fourth-placed team (from the only group of 4) qualify for a group of 5 teams, playing a round robin for positions 9th to 13th.

The match between the 3rd and 4th placed teams from the group of 4 is not played; the result from the first phase prevails.

The matchups will follow the structure established in the Berger Table, for 5 teams.





GIRL'S COMPETITION

19 teams divided into 4 groups

Groups A \rightarrow 4 teams Groups B - D \rightarrow 5 teams

1st phase: round robin inside each group

 2^{nd} phase: Elimination rounds. Ranking system. Top 2 from each group \rightarrow Quarterfinals (1st–8th)

Day 6 finals: Women's Final at 15:00

The first phase is played in a "Round Robin system" (everyone plays each other).

The top two from each group qualify for the ranking from 1st to 8th place in the final standings, with Quarterfinals, Semifinals, and Finals.

The matchups will be: 1st A vs 2nd B, 1st B vs 2nd A, 1st C vs 2nd D, and 1st D vs 2nd C.

The third- and fourth-placed teams qualify for the ranking from 9th to 16th place in the final standings, with 3 additional rounds.

The initial matchups will be: 3rd A vs 4th B, 3rd B vs 4th A, 3rd C vs 4th D, and 3rd D vs 4th C.

The fifth-placed teams qualify for a group of 3 teams, playing a "Round Robin" for positions 17th to 19th.

The matchups will follow the structure established in the Berger Table, for 3 teams.

The ISF Academy is the educational center of the International School Sport Federation delivering online and onsite capacity-building activities for teachers, school sports representatives, coaches, officials, and students around the world. It aims to recognize and or to upgrade the knowledge and skills of any of these stakeholders involved or planning to be involved in national, continental, or international sports, educational networks, institutions, events, or organisation.

The mission of this body is to design and deliver short-, mid-, and long-term quality education and capacity-building activities for students, physical education teachers, national school sport representatives, coaches and officials around the world. These educational programmes will be held online on the ISF Academy platform prior to the events and particularly during the organisation of ISF events on-site, after the competition hours.

Therefore, before and during this international ISF event, heads of delegation, coaches, referees, international school athletes, and local school students will have the opportunity to take part in various interactive educational activities on different topics.

SAFEGUARDING IN SPORT: OUR RESPONSIBILTY, WHAT'S MY ROLE?

We believe that children have the inner resources if educated, to fully understand, identify and react in front of negative behavior such as racism, gender inequity or violence and abuse. The challenge for ISF is to find the right way to express difficult ideas and present complicated topics to young people in order for them, not only to understand but also to appropriately apprehend this issue and be able to react if facing it.

Creating awareness and giving the opportunity for the participants to able to transfer their knowledge when getting back home to their peers is also key to ISF.

The Safeguarding Workshop is designed with young athletes at its core, recognising their central role in the school sport ecosystem. ISF is dedicated to ensuring that all children experience sport participation free from any negative behaviours that could impact their wellbeing. This session of 30 minutes employs interactive and pedagogical methods to provide participants with a clear understanding of safeguarding issues in sport. It aims to teach youth athletes how to recognise interpersonal violence and react appropriately if it occurs to themselves or their peers. This workshop emphasizes creating a culture of respect and integrity for everyone involved in sport as a shared responsibility we all carry so that sport can be a positive experience for all.

ANTI-DOPING EDUCATION

Anti-doping education is of the utmost importance for young people due to several compelling reasons and we believe that young people have the inner resources to fully understand, identify and react in front of negative behaviour such as doping.

Creating awareness and giving the opportunity for the participants to be able to transfer their knowledge when getting back home to their peers is also key to ISF.

Anti-doping education goes beyond the realm of sports. It serves as a platform to impart valuable life lessons and cultivate ethical values in young individuals. By emphasizing the importance of honesty, integrity, and personal responsibility, anti-doping education contributes to the moral development of young athletes. It encourages them to make informed choices, stand up against cheating, and develop a strong sense of integrity that extends beyond the realm of sports and into other aspects of their lives. anti-doping education plays a crucial role in shaping the attitudes and behaviors of young people involved in sports. Educating them about the risks, consequences, and ethical implications of doping, promotes health, fair play, and integrity while providing them with the necessary tools to make informed decisions that align with their long-term well-being and athletic aspirations.

The law and the rules are important, but it is not just rules that safeguard our sport for clean athletes, but also the measures and processes that help put those rules into action. We must all play our part in promoting fair play and that means gaining an appreciation of what leads to certain decisions being made.

December in Shangluo brings the refreshing crispness of early winter. You can expect generally stable weather with plenty of cool, sunny days, providing excellent conditions for outdoor activities and exploration. Average daytime temperatures typically reach a comfortable 8-12°C, though evenings and early mornings will be noticeably cooler. While the climate is predominantly dry, the month may see occasional shifts with some overcast days or light rainfall. A warm sweater or light jacket is recommended to ensure your comfort, especially when moving between indoor and outdoor venues.
