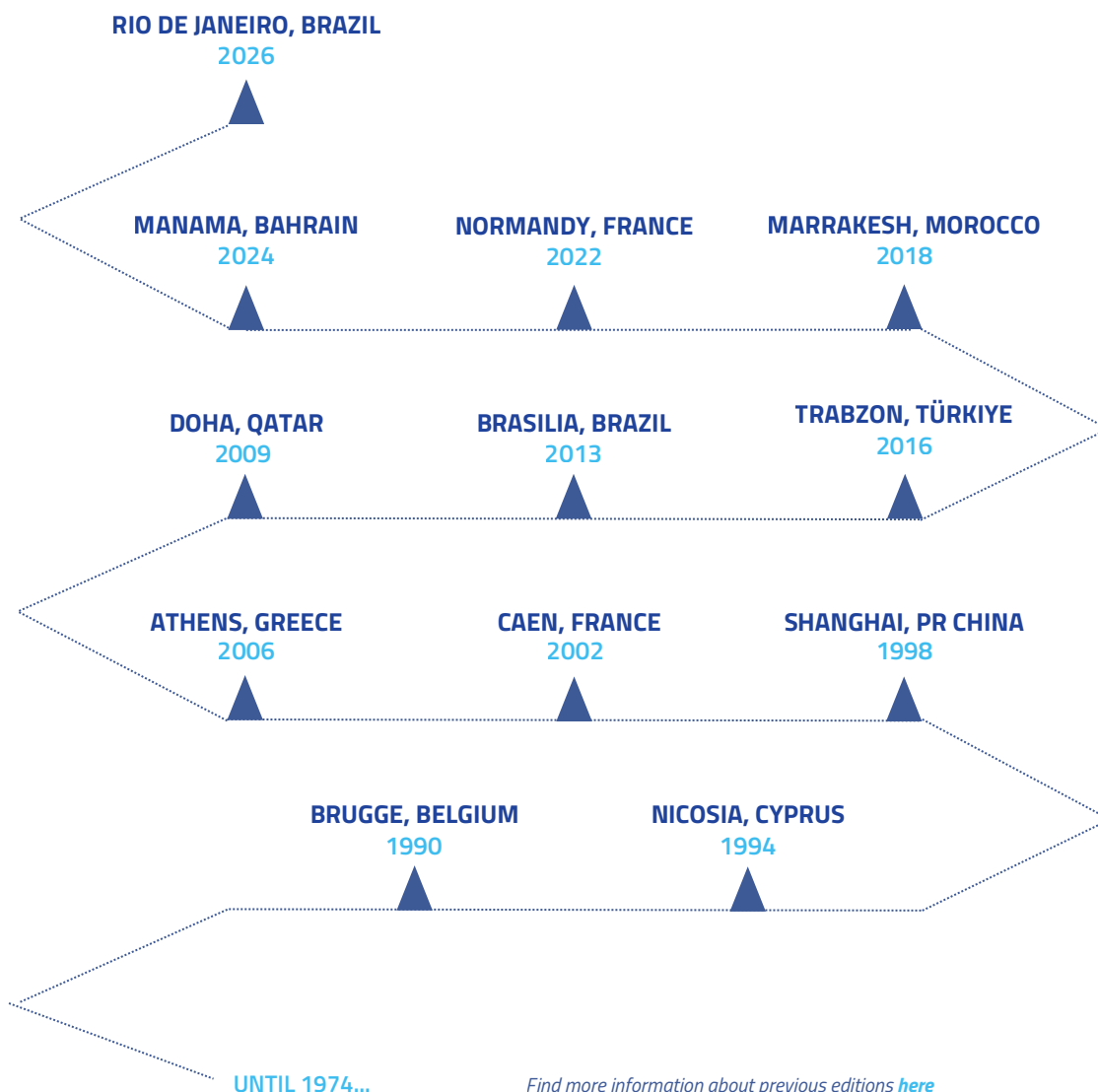

ABOUT ISF GYMNASIADE

The 2026 edition foresees the sporting event taking place over six official days, with a competition program comprising ten sports: Athletics, Para-athletics, Judo, Karate, Taekwondo, Beach Volleyball, Wrestling, Chess, and two exclusively virtual sports: Virtual Cycling and Virtual Rowing, which will be held remotely. It is estimated to accommodate 2,300 participants from approximately 45 countries, and the Organizing Committee is expected to consist of 200 people.

Rio de Janeiro presents itself as one of the most complete and inspiring destinations in the world for hosting major international sporting events, combining excellent infrastructure, a consolidated legacy, and an unparalleled vocation for sport. Host of the Rio 2016 Olympic and Paralympic Games, stage for the 2014 FIFA World Cup and the ISF U15 Gymnasiade 2023, the city has consolidated a robust legacy of multifunctional sports complexes that house world-class arenas, ready to host high-performance competitions such as the ISF U18 Gymnasiade 2026.

► COMPETITION VENUES

The ISF U18 Gymnasiade 2026 will take place in modern, safe and strategically selected sports venues designed to ensure operational excellence, comfort and high performance for student-athletes, delegations and technical teams participating in the event. The competition planning prioritizes logistical integration among sports, aiming to concentrate as many disciplines as possible within connected sports complexes, enhancing participant experience, mobility and international interaction between delegations.



In this edition, the event will feature an important sports facility operated by the Brazilian Armed Forces, nationally recognized for their technical quality, organization, and high-standard sports infrastructure, such as the athletics track at the Air Force University (UNIFA) facilities, used as training grounds for Olympic and Paralympic athletes during the Rio 2016 Games. This venue offers modern, functional, and fully equipped environments, prepared to host international sporting competitions, guaranteeing safety, operational excellence, and a world-class sporting experience for all participants.

Two other Olympic venues will be used in the competition: the Barra da Tijuca Olympic Park (which hosted the largest concentration of events during the Rio 2016 Games) will host the beach volleyball competitions, while the Riocentro Convention & Event Center (venue for various sports during the Rio 2016 Olympic Games) will host the Judo, Karate, Taekwondo, Wrestling, Chess, Rowing and Virtual Cycling events at the Gymnasiade 2026, as well as the organizing committee, the event's main restaurant and fun zone, and the opening, awards and closing ceremonies.

TRAVELLING

► OBLIGATIONS

- All participants must be present for the entire duration of the event, from arrival to departure as stated in the official programme.
- Participation in all non-sport activities is mandatory.
- Each team must compete against all other teams.
- Each participant must compete against all other participants.
- Any absence from the sports programme, ceremonies (opening, prize-giving, closing), or socio-cultural activities may lead to the team's disqualification.
- Delegations must stay in official event accommodation provided by the LOC to participate in the event.

► PORT OF ENTRY

Port of entry:

- GIG = Galeão international airport Tom Jobim (Rio de Janeiro)
- SDU = Santos Dummont international airport (Rio de Janeiro)

► TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Travel to the official ports of entry is to be arranged and financed by each participating delegation. Delegations are to arrive on 2nd or 3rd December 2026 and depart on 8th or 9th December 2026 after breakfast. Organizing an extended stay for the delegation (before or after the event) is a matter of the concerned delegation. It shall not be the responsibility of the Local Organising Committee.

► INSURANCE

Each participating delegation is required to provide insurance for each member of its delegation. At a minimum, the insurance is to cover civil liability, material damage and medical costs.

TRAVELLING

► VISA

Each participating delegation is required to check whether a VISA is required to enter Brazil.

Please contact the relevant Brazilian Embassy or Consulate in your country to consult the necessary VISA application procedures.

The VISA document is granted by Brazilian Consulates abroad, allowing the admission and stay of foreigners within Brazilian territory, provided that all legal requirements established by Brazilian law have been fulfilled.

To apply for a VISA, foreign participants must submit, among other documents:

- VISA application form;
- Valid travel document;
- Proof of payment of consular fees;
- International Certificate of Vaccination, when required;
- Other specific documents depending on the type of VISA requested.

TRAVELLING

► VACCINES

There is currently no mandatory vaccination requirement for entry into Brazil.

However, the Brazilian Ministry of Health recommends that all travellers update their vaccination status prior to arrival in Brazil, according to the immunization schedule guidelines of their country of origin or residence, especially vaccines against yellow fever, poliomyelitis, measles, rubella, diphtheria and tetanus.

Yellow Fever

According to the guidelines of the Brazilian Health Regulatory Agency (ANVISA), the Brazilian regulatory authority for traveller health, Brazil does not require proof of yellow fever vaccination for foreign or Brazilian travellers entering the country.

Although not mandatory for entry into Brazil, yellow fever vaccination is recommended for all travellers — both foreign and Brazilian — at least ten days before travelling, allowing sufficient time for the vaccine to generate antibodies and ensure adequate protection.

The vaccine is contraindicated for children under six months of age, adults over 60 years old, pregnant women, breastfeeding women with infants up to six months old, cancer patients and immunocompromised individuals. In situations involving epidemiological emergencies, outbreaks, epidemics or travel to risk areas, physicians should evaluate the risks and benefits of vaccination for these groups, considering the possibility of adverse events.

Yellow fever is an acute febrile infectious disease caused by a virus transmitted by mosquito vectors and has two transmission cycles: sylvatic (rural or forest areas) and urban. The virus is transmitted through the bite of infected mosquitoes and there is no direct person-to-person transmission. Yellow fever has important epidemiological relevance due to its clinical severity and potential spread in urban areas infested by the *Aedes aegypti* mosquito.

REGISTRATION

► REGISTRATION PROCESS

The only recognised method of registration is through **ERAS** - the ISF official registration platform. Within the platform there will be 2 sections of registration:

- for ISF members
- for Non-ISF members

Please select the appropriate section related to your registration type.

Each ISF member country/region is automatically entitled to have their own credentials to access ERAS. For non-ISF members registration, access will be provided following submission of information through this initial step.

If you encounter any other problems, please contact the ISF secretariat at registration@isfsports.org. Registration to the Event will be divided into **2 phases**:

PHASE 1

Sign up

Registration will be done through the official ISF registration system ERAS. Participating delegations will be required to register their members and make Deposit payments.

Information to be entered in:

- **The exact number** of athletes (boys/girls), coaches, and additional adults;
- **Events** (by sport) and their discipline(s), which the athletes will be registered in ;
- **Name**, date of birth date, gender, and passport copy.

PHASE 2

Collecting data & information

Delegations are expected to enter the exact detailed information :

- Final detailed information for each participant (dietary requirements, personal bests, jersey number)
- Upload all needed documents online
- Submitting the expected date of arrival and departure, and type of transport

COMPOSITION OF DELEGATION

► COMPOSITION OF DELEGATION

Each delegation shall consist of:

1. **Head of delegation - *mandatory***
2. **Student athlete(s) - *mandatory***
3. **Team officials - *mandatory***
4. **Safeguarding officer - *mandatory***
5. **National authority - *optional***
6. **Field of Play Officials (referees/umpires/judges) - *optional***
7. **Additional adults - *optional***
8. **Delegation Media staff - *optional***

Head of the delegation

There is a mandatory amount of one (1) head of the delegation per registering delegation.

- The head of the delegation shall be the sole intermediary between the delegation and the Local Organising Committee, and the ISF.
- He/she may not combine the function with any other official role (i.e., coach, referee, etc.).

Student-athletes

- All student-athletes must be enrolled as full-time students at a school in the country/region in which they represent. All student-athletes must be attending schools that provide general education and/or vocational education incorporating segments of general education.
- Only athletes, registered on the team's list handed in at the accreditation, are authorised to take part in this competition.
- The following are *not* eligible to participate:
 - Attendees of vocational schools only attend a school as a complement to their vocational training and are not full-time students with a segment of general education.
 - Students enrolled at schools that provide sports training without any general education.

COMPOSITION OF DELEGATION

► COMPOSITION OF DELEGATION

Team officials (Coaches and Other Team Officials)

Coaches

- The coach shall train/direct student-athletes in the competition.
- The presence of coaches is mandatory.

Other Team Officials

- The function of other team officials can be Doctor, trainers, Physiotherapists, Statisticians, Team managers, etc.)
- The function of each other team officials must be specified during the registration process.

Safeguarding officer

Mandatory role for each delegation. Safeguarding officers shall have the ability to identify situations which cause concern to the safety and wellbeing of youth during events. This person can combine roles and be at the same time coach or any other adult delegation member.

National Authority

The function of each national authority must be specified during the registration process (government representative, ministry representative, etc.).

Field of play officials – FOPO (judges, referees, umpires)

Depending on the sport and on the number of athletes entered, it is requested the registering delegation provide the required number of FOPOs. Failure to provide the required number of Field of play officials (referees, judges, umpires) will lead to a fine of 900 EUR per missing FOPO.

Additional adults

The function of each additional adult must be specified during the registration process.

Delegation Media Staff

National media staff support delegations by managing media coverage, coordinating press interactions, and ensuring key messages are communicated effectively during events

► FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

To participate, each delegation is required to make two (2) payments:

1/ Deposit payment

2/ Balance fee payment

1/ Deposit payment

In order to submit and validate the registration, the delegation will need to pay a deposit of **120€ per participant**.

Please note that participation in the event is granted only by the deposit payment per registered participant.

- The sum will be deducted from the total participation cost.
- The deposit must be sent as a single payment for the whole delegation
- The deposit is non-refundable in the event of non-participation.
- All bank charges are to be met by the participants.

All deposits for the registered teams per category **are to be paid by 01.09.2026**.

If the deposits are not paid within the deadline, the registrations will not be considered valid and automatically deleted from ERAS.

Balance fee payment = Participation fee - Deposit (*already paid*)

The balance fee payment is to be paid before the start of the event to the LOC account (LOC bank instruction will be published in Bulletin 2. All bank charges are to be met by the participating delegation).

Participation fee

The participation fee covers full board accommodation for the duration of the event plus competition, cultural program activities, and all local transport from the arrival to the official port of entry to the departure of the delegation.

The participation fee is composed of:

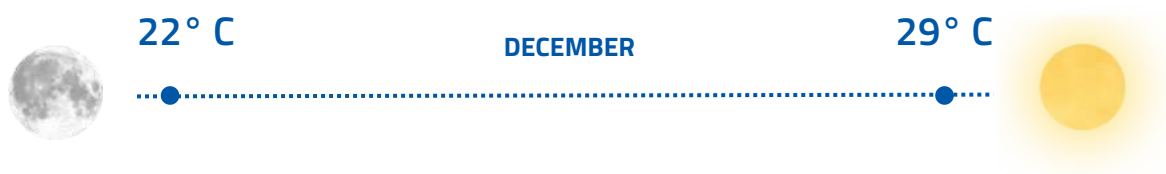

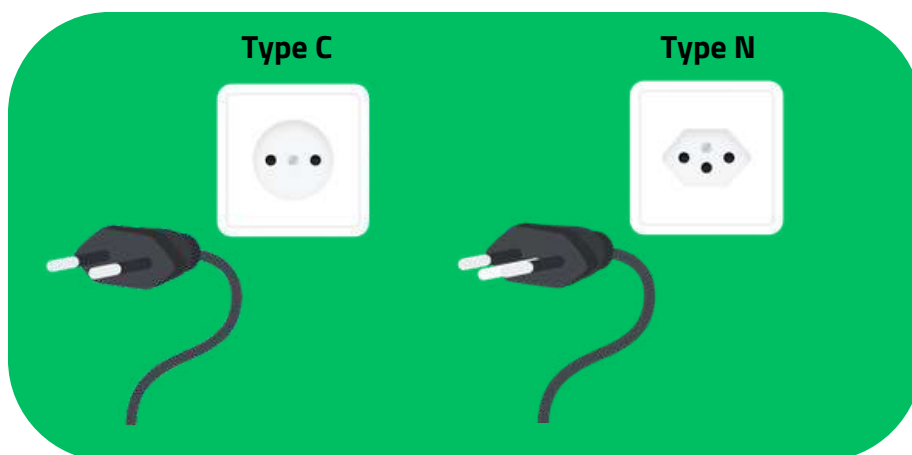

Power plug

For Brazil there are two associated plug types, types C and N. Plug type C is the plug which has two round pins. Plug type N is the plug which has two round pins and a grounding pin. Brazil operates on a 127/220V supply voltage and 60Hz. The power supply in Rio de Janeiro is 127V, however some of the newer hotels operate at 127V and 220V.
