INTERVIEW OF THE DAY



Amaury Leveau (France) - Olympic champion in the 4x100 meters freestyle relay at the Olympic Games in London in 2012, champion and world record holder, several times European champion and record holder.

HOW DOES ONE BECOME AN OLYMPIC CHAMPION?

- I am very lucky to have the title of Olympic champion, but I don't really know how it is done... It seems to me however, that perhaps the most important thing is hard work and commitment.

WHAT CHANGED IN YOUR LIFE AFTER WINNING THIS TITLE?

- After I won the Olympic gold medal, a lot more people began to recognize me in the street, and I have become more "sought after" by various circles. However, as far as myself and my life is concerned, I don't think I have changed - I still treat people the same way and I have the same friends as before.

YOU MUST HAVE VISITED MANY SWIMMING FACILITIES AROUND THE WORLD. HOW DOES THE SWIMMING COMPLEX IN POZNAN COMPARE?

- Yes, it's true, I've competed at quite a number of swimming pools, but to give you an example, in many French cities larger than Poznan there are no such multifunctional facilities with an Olympic swimming pool and diving boards. I am glad to see that in Poland, swimming is becoming increasingly popular and that modern sports and leisure centres are being built.

KALONTAROV Ziv, Omer – Israel, time 50.49 (Boys' 100m Freestyle, School teams)



WHO BESIDES YOURSELF IS MOST PLEASED WITH THIS SUCCESS?

- This gold medal will definitely please my whole family, who incidentally are swimmers too. My coach is now my dad, and when I was little, my mother trained me.

HOW MANY HOURS A DAY DO YOU HAVE TO TRAIN TO BECOME A WORLD CHAMPION?

- I train approximately 21 hours a week, including a morning workout 3 times a week, as well as two hours in the afternoon, and some extra exercises.

SZUCSIK Bence, Hungary, time 58.09 (Men's 100m Backstroke, Selected teams)

WHAT WAS YOUR GREATEST SPORTING SUCCESS BEFORE THIS?

- Before getting the World Champion gold medal in Poznan, I won 1st place in the Hungarian National Championship.

HOW MANY YEARS HAVE YOU BEEN TRAINING?

- I have been swimming since 2005, and I have training 2-6 hours a day.



SAKCI Hueseyin Emre, Ozel Fatih Koleji –Turkey, time 29.41(Boys' 50m Breaststroke, School teams)

APART FROM YOUR VICTORY, WHAT WILL YOU REMEMBER MOST ABOUT POZNAN?

- For the moment I like best the evening parties and banquets, with new friends from all over the world.

WHO IS YOUR SWIMMING IDOL?

- For now I don't have any idol, I try to be my own inspiration...

DOES YOUR FAMILY ALREADY KNOW ABOUT YOUR GOLD MEDAL IN POZNAN?

- Yes, my family already knows about my success. My grandparents were the first to hear about it, as they came to cheer me on in Poznan, and later the rest of my family in France were delighted to discover I had the gold medal.

HOW LONG HAVE YOU BEEN IN YOUR COUNTRY'S SCHOOL REPRESENTATION?

- The World Championship in Poznan is the third time I have competed in the colours of the French national team.

AN Ting-Yao, Chinese Taipei, time 1:51.48 (Men's 200m Freestyle, Selected teams)

WERE YOU COUNTING ON SUCH A SUCCESS IN POZNAN?

- Not in the least - the gold medal has come as a big surprise for me and the rest of our representatives!

AT WHAT KIND OF FACILITY DO YOU TRAIN IN YOUR HOME COUNTRY?

- In Chinese Taipei I perfect my skills in the swimming pool of one of the high school in my city.
